

Epachois Hospital Bed Setup Guide

A simple printable checklist for preparing your room, receiving delivery, and setting up a home hospital bed.

Before Delivery

- Measure front door, bedroom door, hallway width, hallway turns, and bedroom floor space.
- Clear a path from the entrance to the room.
- Choose a flat, stable location near a grounded outlet.
- Plan for two adults to help with setup and moving heavy components.
- Keep the order number and tracking information available.

Room Fit Checklist

- Leave caregiver clearance on at least one side of the bed.
- Confirm space for a wheelchair, walker, overbed table, or caregiver chair if needed.
- Avoid blocking vents, door swings, or emergency access.
- Place the bed where the remote cord and power cord can be used safely.

During Setup

- Place the bed on a flat surface and lock caster wheels before use.
- Confirm the mattress, rails, remote, and accessories are secure.
- Test head, foot, and height adjustment before the patient uses the bed.
- Keep power cords away from walking paths and moving bed parts.

After Setup

- Review basic operation with the caregiver and patient.
- Store manuals, order number, and warranty information in one place.
- Check wheels, rails, remote cable, and power cord weekly.
